### A My Testimony Involves and Requires Unity

You need to read this to understand how all this confusion developed. I never appreciated that my desire to become a physician was established far back at the age of 7 by my mom. She often introduced me to her friends as "My son the doctor." My mom played in the Lancaster Symphony, so I heard noteworthy violin music growing up. I followed suite playing in the Savannah Symphony.

I encountered my first significant battles in Junior High School by anti-Semites who I describe as a person who hates a Jew more than they had to. Without any Bible interest or training, I forced myself to memorize Exodus 1:12: "The more they afflicted them, the more they multiplied and grew. And they were in dread of the children of Israel." This came with a wonderful peace.

We moved multiple times, because my father was a furniture salesman. One of those times, I was blessed to meet Paul in Philadelphia. He was a third-year medical student who basically adopted me and confirmed the desires of my heart to study medicine as a physician. I also met Dr. Arthur during an insurance exam who almost treated me like his son. He increased my belief levels toward this field through his books and patient information.

I was totally blessed when I was accepted into Albright College in Reading, Pennsylvania for Premed. My first challenge was entering into a religion class with only a brief background course in Hebrew before the age of thirteen. Would you believe my term paper was entitled, "Why there is no God?"

In my last year, my physics professor continued to be agreeable to write my many medical school applications. One day he stopped me as I left his classroom and informed me, "Phil, I have written so many letters for you that I'm beginning to believe them."

Unfortunately, I received a letter of rejection from the very first medical school I applied to. I was too upset to get depressed, but the next day I spoke to my mom who was a bookkeeper for the Philadelphia Lyric Opera Company. She instructed me to write to the medical school of my choice and inform them that I had already been accepted to another school but wanted to attend their four-year program instead. Would you believe it, but just a week later, I was accepted to my first choice, New York Medical College?

During my four years in medical school, which I loved, I would spend five to six hours of nightly study and fifteen hours on the weekend. Dropping my homework into the bathtub never helped.

My greatest thrills occurred during the following four years of residency when I opened my neurosurgical practice.

B Unity is still in the process of battling in order to persist.

Early in my career, I developed chronic pain in both feet referred to as Plantar Fasciitis. I had to live with this because my medical colleagues diagnosed it as incurable.

I began to search for an answer outside my Jewish faith, especially when I heard a pastor talk about the supernatural realm and that it's really God's will to heal you. I had mixed emotions about this but decided to adopt a saying that seemed more positive: "If you can see the invisible, you can accomplish the impossible." I told this to my office nurse, and the next day, as part of our office humor, she took advantage of my words by teasing me, "Doctor Phil, there's a ghost in the waiting room to see you." I told her, "Tell him I'm too busy to see him."

My challenge was to overcome this intense pain, especially when I had to operate without anti-pain medication.

When my mom heard what I was enduring, she gave me rather definite instructions. She stated quite clearly on the telephone, "If you ever decide to become a Christian, please don't tell me."

This suffering persisted for almost three years, but so did my Christian research. I was finally encouraged to visit Pastor Benny Hinn at the Orlando Church in Florida. During the service, I got to sit in the front row with the TV screen on the podium. I got to watch all the healing activities. After the choir finished singing, the pastor requested that they "Now, I want you to pray in tongues." As I listened to these weird sounds, I thought, "What in the world is this noisy weird sound?" I suddenly felt intense heat in my feet along with a pressure sensation. I was totally stunned and unaware of what was happening. When the heat stopped, so did the pain, which quickly and totally disappeared. At that point, I realized what had happened. I jumped up and began to cry. One of the staff members came over to me, and said, "That was Jesus who healed you." My first reaction was to deny that because I didn't see Him. I also had doubts about it being Jesus because we were both Jewish. This was my first exposure to the supernatural realm through Jesus Christ.

A new flower workshop accidentally mixed up their first order as they opened shop. The sports store loved the flowers, but they were upset with the plaque that read, "Rest in Peace." The flower shop apologized but pointed out it could have been worse because the funeral home also loved the flowers but were angry with the plaque that read, "Good luck in your new location."

C Unity begins growing into its proper accord.

Multiple healings began to occur. I began to see more people healed by the laying on of hands than I did by the scalpel. A policeman- fireman required a respirator from trauma, but through Jesus was healed. Philippians 2:9-10, (NKJV): " Therefore, God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth."

Denial began to become a major situation as more people were attempted to be healed. I had to interpret this new category in healing called De Nile to represent that big river in Egypt.

Part of my spiritual training involved the reading of five hundred such books, viewing multiple videos, CD's, DVD's, and exposure to the Internet and multiple ministers and pastors.

Years later my mom was hospitalized, and I visited her. A nurse came into the room to provide her with medication. She had sustained a rotator cuff injury, causing shoulder pain. She was healed and then received the prayer of salvation through Jesus. My mom then asked to receive Jesus. I sat down quickly next to her on her bed and she was born again through the prayer in Romans 10:9,10, received salvation. Immediately afterward, she responded, "Thank you for giving me Jesus."

I was making morning rounds at the hospital, and I walked into my patient's room to discuss her status. After I sat down, I started asking her questions about her activities. Then she asked me how long I've been in practice? I told her I never practiced but did the real thing. I started eating some of the peanuts in the container on her nightstand. Suddenly I stopped and said to her when I realized, "Sandy, I thought I told you not to eat peanuts with your medical condition!" She said, "I didn't! I listened to you doc. As soon as I suck the chocolate off, I put the peanuts back in the container."

## 2. Unity Overcomes Demonic Activity

Let's direct ourselves now toward the most important concern in this entire book, our solution to handling the demonic forces. That is, our worse enemy, demonic forces. To respond to this with the strength you need and avoid defeat, God wants you to build a great relationship with Him involving His will and His word. They're both the same.

The truth is that we are at war from the time we are born until the time we go home to Heaven. Just like soldiers are trained with their weapons, we must learn how to use our armaments, which, again, turns out to be the power of God through His word. This means we don't get confused, for we are all fighting against demons, not each other. There are too many intellectual minds stuck in the secular world because they don't understand that the only way to conquer demonic activity and prevent demons from controlling us is through Jesus Christ.

First off, if you don't know who the Holy Spirit is and don't recognize He's alive your life, then you need to be born again. John 3:3 "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born [a]gain, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

You already know you were born the first time of the flesh, through your parents. But now you must be born again the second time of the Holy Spirit. The basic challenge here is to rely on God's wisdom, not the wisdom of the world because worldly wisdom is a misnomer. Salvation is really the only answer, the greatest miracle in all the world that you or I or anyone can ever receive.

The Salvation Born Again Prayer is so simple, so clear, so comprehensible, so understandable, and so positive, but best of all, it's so prophetic. It's the greatest demonic protection you can or will ever receive. Here's the miracle. This turns out to be a joyful package deal because it includes a free ticket to heaven. Speak the following out loud: "Father, thank you for forgiving me of my sins. Jesus, come into my heart and make me the kind of person you want me to be. I receive you as my Savior and Lord. Father, thank you for saving me today." Don't forget to celebrate this like all the angels will. Here's biblical proof from Hebrews 1:14: "Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?"

I ministered to a woman in Hong Kong and told her this story after Jesus healed her. Mr. and Mrs. Wong had a baby and the doctor decided for both to see their sweetheart. His wife was already in her room when the doctor carried the newborn into the room. They both stared at this white baby and they both spoke out loud together, "That's not our baby!" The doctor immediately responded, "Of course that's your baby. I was there or the delivery. Why do you deny it?" because two wongs don't make a white."

### 3. Introduction to Unity Definition of Unity: A Positive Path for Spiritual Living

Have you ever considered what you would like to be when you grow up? Put humor aside for now. This question may make more sense to you if you ask yourself, "What have I been doing until now getting ready for the end days? What do I want to share from my life so I can accomplish significant goals?" My future destiny, like yours, was never a discussable subject in school, among friends or family, peers, and rarely amongst my parents. These thoughts might have entered my subconscious mind, but I wasn't aware of it.

The subconscious mind is like a huge memory bank with unlimited capacity. It permanently stores everything that ever happens to us and responds exactly the way we have programmed ourselves.

This mind of ours makes everything we say fit into a pattern that is consistent with our self-concept; that is, it becomes our "master program." Despite this unique capacity within us, we often underestimate ourselves and worry. Here's a great definition of worry today is the tomorrow you worried about yesterday. Worry creates anxiety, which in turn causes depression.

My biggest concern used to be, what if I don't have anything to worry about? My attempt at using humor here is my way of releasing any drama zones over time that may have accumulated in my brain or worse, in my heart. The only alternative way to handle this is to simply save your drama for your mama. Then you can give up the following, which you really don't need by this time in your life: attention, parent-like caring, and sympathy. There are better ways to achieve this than by manipulating others. This also includes any other emotional challenges that attempt to control you. You accomplish so much more when you replace all your uncontrolled emotions with intentional excitement.

One of my unity challenges was that I never knew how to react to living in a family of Orthodox Jews. Both of my uncles would tell me, "We were born Jews and we intent to die Jews."

I was aware of the opportunity of having undesignated goals in my mind, but I didn't know what to do with them. Then I came across a precious saying that affected me: "Most men die with their dreams still in them." I couldn't explain this for a long time, at least until I began to realize, and then understood, there was a godly reason for our existence other than just existing.

Ideally, we all need a mentor, someone who can tell us the truth and help us with our challenges, especially during these end times. This should be the perfect time to bring in your parents. But if that's not likely for one reason or another, it could be your grandparents. I was taught that when God gets too busy, He passes His assignments

over to our grandparents. My grand mom often provided godly advice. But the strongest consideration should be your pastor.

However, just because God isn't mentioned here first doesn't mean He's being ignored. He's your obvious answer when you see the difference He makes. You can be totally blessed by Him as your mentor, in contrast to those who are still searching for help in their secular, natural or demonic world. Millions of people throughout our nations need to hear and respond to God's urgent plea: "Turn to me and be saved" (Isaiah 45:22, NASB).

God's mission is to reconcile us back to Him and make us into a new creature, formed with a new mind, a new purpose, a new heart and focused on His will and His word. This means we all need to step into the spiritual world, which is not in desperate need of God's love because it already exists here. A Christian scholar stated that we were never meant to leave earth and go to Heaven, but rather to be Christ's ambassadors and bring Heaven to earth, just as the Lord's Prayer states.

Three women die in a car crash. They are all quite surprised to meet St. Peter. He not only lets them see and hear the activities at each of their funerals, but also grants them the privilege to have the people say whatever each woman would like to hear.

The teacher wants to hear that she was the best teacher her students ever had and that they learned continuously from her training. She helped them achieve their goals in life. The realtor wants to hear from the mourners that she was the best salesperson the company ever had, and that she not only sold more homes than anyone else, but the people realized that they received wonderful blessings from living in the new quarters she sold to them. Then St. Peter asked the nurse what she would like to hear the mourners say, and she responded, "Look, she's moving."

#### 4. Creative Unity

We have a precious God who is already invisible, but who can yet make things work visibility. In other words, we can be spiritually minded even though He is invisible to the natural mind. Catch this passage from Scripture, which covers that: "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him" (John 14:7). The truth is, even more definite than that, is that you can also see Him mentally. David's battle history in the Bible fascinates me for He was able to kill both the lion and the bear. Understand that this was accomplished because God was with him. Yes, I believe he saw God with him mentally. I never appreciated that! That's exactly how he killed Goliath. He was able to see God mentally. And you can do that as well. By the way, you may not know why Goliath's mom was so critical of her son going out with David. Every time he did, Goliath would come home stoned.

Moses also went through many challenges in his life, which he was able to handle, because he also saw God with him mentally. To add to this, you need to believe God's word and reinforce it so you can utilize His power. The scriptural words are from Hebrews 13:5-6, (NKJV): "Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we may boldly say: "The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"

"We can learn to see with our spiritual eyes because God has not only promised us but has given us that ability. He also wants us to have the desires of our heart. This is a combination of the spiritual world and the mental world. Again, just believe you can see yourself with God, both mentally and spiritually. Yes, that's quite simple especially when you use your imagination. When you believe, you receive. Repeat this saying often even when you're in the process of imagining what's necessary: "When you believe, you receive." God's word confirms this: "While we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal" (2 Corinthians 4:18). The good news is that we have God's glory along with His reputation.

Listen to this. To further explain how we have both spiritual and physical eyes, understand we have been given the gift of discerning of spirits, one of the nine gifts of the Holy Spirit. (Since we also have signs and wonders, this means we have all nine gifts of the Holy Spirit. In addition to our seeing in the physical realm, we can see better using the spiritual realm. Understand that you can do that when you close your physical eyes and start seeing with your spiritual eyes by using your imagination. That's how you can see things happening in the supernatural realm. To extend this and make it real, picture the home you think you can't afford to buy, the great car you would like to drive, or whatever else you want. Just stay with it until it happens. Using the spiritual visual realm rather than the natural physical visual realm is how our imaginations allow us to make

these things happen. This gift of the Holy Spirit works because people can use their imaginations in the supernatural realm to picture their medical sicknesses and diseases disappearing. This is real and keeps on happening. Why not see God as your doctor instead of your previous physician when you are told you have a poor prognosis or similar negative words describing your current medical situation? This means you can resolve bad news merely by changing doctors.

With practice, you can learn to see God twenty-four hours a day. Start seeing the things you need but be careful not to exalt the sensational over the supernatural.

For additional help, when you drive down the highway in your car, like Pastor Norval Hayes did, spend time talking to Jesus, whom you can readily picture sitting next to you. Remember, there is no victory without history.

A bus driver and a minister arrive together in heaven. The minister is assigned to an old shack and must walk everywhere. The bus driver is driven to a mansion with the best accommodations of everything, including a chauffeur. At the monthly heavenly conference meeting, the minister complains to St. Peter, "These accommodations are atrocious. Why should that bus driver live better than I do?" St. Peter answers, "When you were a minister and preached, many people fell asleep during your sermons. When the bus driver drove the bus, all the people would pray openly."

## 5. Unity Is Being Together

Living together must start with people being open to helping one another. The truth is the only way to accomplish that is for people to learn to love one other. Don't be in love with yourself but do love yourself. No matter how many other people love you, if you don't love yourself you will still be lonely. This simply requires practice to the point it becomes acceptable as a daily and frequent routine. This is amazing as you see yourself growing together in unity with others.

Once you can overcome how we act and react differently to different people we would be totally blessed during these final days. Our primary purpose of the law here is to restore our relationships between our Holy God and the sinful man. Once you understand that God loves us and the sinners, not their sins, we will be able to reestablish the foundation for our relationships with one another.

Studying the commandments enables us to recognize the signposts rather than a set of rules so we are guided forward in the precise direction we need to go. When Jesus was asked, "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." And the second is just like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Laws and the Prophets (Matthew 22:36–40). This obviously means if you aren't crazy about your neighbor, how do you resolve this. Jesus points out that we must love our enemies in the same way He does. This really works, even if you don't want to struggle to rectify it. One of the shortcuts here is to love the ones who are easier to love.

An elderly man fed up with the way he had to live his life, decides to enter a monastery. He was tired of living in the streets, searching for sleeping quarters, and attempting to find food in the trash containers. He understood the restricted regimen he would have to follow. He was presented with a three year-trial before he could be fully accepted as a monk. He could say only two words at the end of each year, but to continue working hard. After completing the first year he told the Abbot, and everyone else in the classroom, "Food bad." At the end of the second year he stated, in the same environment, "Bed hard." At the final year meeting, everyone expected good news, especially the Senior Officer. Instead the man yelled, "I quit!" The Abbot quickly responded, "Good! No wonder you quit. All you've done is complain since you have been here!"



## 6. Unity Is the Word of God

The most powerful Scripture in my opinion to accomplish what we want to speak into existence is Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV). "Death and life are in the power of the tongue. And those who love it will eat it's fruit."

This means you can have whatever you say according to Jesus because you're planning to witness what you are about to confess. The speech center in your brain has power over all the nerves and synapses in your body. This means the Word of God must become like a spiritual prescription. These Scriptures preserve the power of the tongue, such as Proverbs 13:3 (NKJV). "He who guards his mouth preserves his lie. But he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction." There are about one hundred great Scriptures regarding the power of the tongue, and medical science has validated all these truths.

When you indulge in Scriptures to accomplish your purpose, there are profound changes that can occur both in your faith and your belief system. For example, I speak the following quite often because it gives me an extraordinary energy boost while I'm attempting to figure out how to handle whatever challenge I may encounter. Philippians 4:13 (NKJV) "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" How about this one? (Mark 11:24) (NKJV) "Therefore, I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them" This is what really makes your prayers come to life and solves whatever challenges you're going through.

This powerful information has been hidden for thousands of years, (I can confirm this never being taught this in medical school or practice) which is why people still don't believe it and aren't able to utilize the power of His word. Again, when you speak negatively instead of positively, you will witness it happening thanks to the devil.

Here's another example. When you decide to leave work and say, "I have retired," there will be a slowdown in your activities, just as you spoke and predicted it. The better word to use for your new career when you stop working is to "refire" instead of "retire." This power of positive thinking and speaking must be applied to everything you do. Negative speaking places a negative label on what you're saying, which enables the demonic spirits to carry out and activate your negative words. How about this new approach? Not only are you young and excited, but you are refired because Jesus, who is living in you, has totally strengthened you with His joy.

From now on, when you speak inappropriately, just holler, "Cancel, cancel!" When you do receive a negative word, even a swear word from someone, just respond back by saying, "Bless you, or I don't receive that."

As Scripture says in Jeremiah 1:9-10 (NKJV) "Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: 'Behold, I have put My words in your mouth.

See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, to root out and to pull down, To destroy and to throw down, To build and to plant”

A man signs in at the doctor's office for an appointment. After waiting for what he thought was an extremely long period of time, he gets up and tells the receptionist, "I will be back. I need to get a haircut." She says, "The doctor will be with you shortly. He was late coming to the office. Another period passes, and he goes back to the receptionist and says, "I'll I be back. I need to get a haircut." She responds, "I told you the doctor is still busy catching up, but he will be with you shortly. Besides, why didn't you get a haircut before you came here?" He said to her, "I didn't need one when I came here."

## 7. God Supplies Your Goals through Unity

Why do so many of us growing up without any definite prominent goals in our life? You can't help but think, is there a way we can help them? Are they just existing? There is an obvious reason for these end days and there is no coincidence God has us living here during these times.

I believe this is a true story I copied so that there is hope for everyone. One day, a pastor is strolling through the park near his church when he stops to talk to a couple sitting on a bench. He says, "What's your dream in life?"

The girl replies, "I don't know, but this has been on my mind for years."

He says, "I am a Christian, and God often talks to me about dreams for my church members. Is it okay if we pray and ask God to show you a dream for your life?"

"That would be great."

"Now, repeat the following as I speak it. Jesus, you know I love you and I know you love me. I know you created me not only to enjoy life but to live it to its fullness. Please let me know why and what I was created for." Several minutes later, she says with great enthusiasm, "I just heard the Lord tell me He wants me to become a chef. And would you believe it, but my aunt owns a restaurant downtown."

The pastor says, "I told you Jesus will give you the answer. Now, write down what you heard and continue to thank him, especially after you call your aunt."

The doctor is impressed. "That sounds really difficult." "No, it's quite easy; I've been doing it since I was ten." "What's the secret?" "Doc, I can't reveal our trade secrets." "Oh, I understand. I was just curious. I would never attempt anything like that. Tell me, Kevo, are there any more like you at home?" "Just a half-sister."

## 8. Leadership Is a Unity Skill

The Meriam-Webster definition of leadership is 1) the office or position of leadership, 2) the capacity to lead, and 3) the act or instance of leading.

The factors involved are supposed to sets precedence. When you are punctual you are on time.

1) A professional is one dressed for success. Leading by example sets precedence. You interact with everyone by being courteous. Humility is very important because it requires more confidence. Stay a leader instead of becoming a boss. Share the spotlight and give credit to others.

2) Leaders become very effective at communication, so they are both heard and understood. The especially are aware of the importance of listening.

3) All meetings must be run productively and run smoothly without any micromanaging.

4) Beware of limits and set and maintain boundaries when necessary.

5) Be aware of the need for a mentor. Be open to other opinions to avoid a lack of knowledge. Know when to turn to someone else for help. Find who to trust for advice. Stay emotionally aware. Maintain relationships. Be aware of emotional attachments. Become sensitive and stable to different points of view. Stay emotionally intelligent. Be aware of dealing with different backgrounds.

6) To the best of your ability, avoid mistakes.

7) Be careful to avoid past failures. Don't be doomed by repeating them. Lessons for success can be found everywhere.

8) Stay in tune and in touch for the availability of examples of successful business models. Always think positively.

9) Be careful who you team-up with especially those that are in favor of your decisions.

10) Maintain great leaders as they develop and continue directing your mind to great ideas and new possibilities.

Leadership Prayer: 1 John 5:14 (NKJV) "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him."

I wonder if it would make a difference to world leaders if they knew that someday, they'll stand before Christ and must account for themselves.

"it's like talking to a wall."

## 9. Unity in Water

Dr. Masaru Emoto is a physician entrepreneur from Japan who graduated with a degree in alternative medicine. He discovered an unbelievable property of water. He learned that when water placed in small petri dishes is exposed to various frozen stimuli, utilizing other treatments, beautifully shining hexagonal crystals are formed. The same thing happens when water is exposed to short but positive spoken phrases like "I love you." However, when exposed to negative stimuli, such as saying, "You fool," the opposite effect occurs, and this creates ugly formations. He called all these various responses the invisible world of water. For example, exposure to classical music and similar sounds were positive, but rock and roll music demonstrated negative formations. His staff became absorbed in his water laboratory, and their work endeavors extended into fifteen years of research. Several bestselling books visualizing beautiful photography were published, the names included "Water Knows the Answer" and "Messages from Water." This means that the words of Scripture we speak have the same effect on us as they do on the spiritual nature of water. You must appreciate that the percentage of water in our bodies is forty-five to sixty percent for females and fifty to sixty-five percent for males? This means there is a tremendous positive affect when you speak to your body or someone else's body.

I only see two businessmen fly into Los Angeles for a morning financial conference. They sit in seats 4A and 4B on the flight. When they arrive at the hotel, they are taken to room forty-four on the fourth floor. While seated at the breakfast lounge, they check their table and notice they are sitting at table four. When the waitress takes their order, they notice her badge is #4. Suddenly, they both look at each other with the same idea. "Let's go down to the racetrack and cash in on this" So they bet on horse # 4 in the fourth race. Guess what? He comes in fourth! What did you expect?

## 10. Communicate Through Unity

Ever wonder why growing into maturity is accomplished through a powerful and supernatural God? We become smarter and more successful as we lead with a greater quality of life and live in victory, peace, and joy.

His unrelenting love is already appreciated and demonstrated by His sending and sacrificing His one and only Son on earth. John 3:16. (NKJV) "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but having everlasting life." Jesus has enabled us to overcome the impossible, such as tribulations (trials), sickness, disease, and adverse circumstances. Furthermore, the three divine realms He speaks about are the kingdom, the power and the glory. We have already discussed that God dwells in the spiritual reality in the dimension of eternity. He manifests in the invisible form in the natural dimension. Revelation is really God's knowledge revealed to our spirits which means it is received by us in the spiritual realms through seeing, hearing, and perceiving. We in turn receive in the supernatural senses when given to us by the Holy Spirit. He teaches us, gives us gifts, and provides the presence of the Lord. Only revelation will reveal God's human nature and the origins of man and life.

The reason we are forced to criticize everything is simply because we can't create or explain and instead depend on intellectual knowledge; it's a poor substitute. The truth is it's your faith that can make you whole. A great definition is this. Hebrews 11:1–3 INKJV). "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible."

To discuss the natural realm, it is subject to the laws of time, space, and matter. It can only be accessed through the physical senses. A miracle is the supernatural intervention of God that interrupts the normal course of our natural lives.

Religion occurs as the result of not having an experience with God. To explain the difference between Christianity and every other religion in the world is simple. Religions are about man trying to reach up to God, while Christianity is about God reaching down to man.

My wife informed me there were no available walls in our home to place my newly caught beautiful swordfish. So, I had to find one in my office for this fixture. ## 11. Unity of Seed Faith

You need to understand that everything in life starts with a seed. When we put our faith in God's hands it's like a seed, we plant We are giving Him something to work with, and He will send the miracle we need. No matter how small our faith seems to be, it will meet our needs and solve problems that appear as impossible to move as mountains. Genesis 8:22 (NKJV) "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, and day and night Shall not cease."

God sees and treasures every seed you sow into His kingdom. Sowing involves a positive attitude of expecting results. So, look forward to receiving the following: abundance, joy, peace, favor, harvest, power, and intimacy. To appreciate the joy of receiving, you must first experience the joy of giving because this trait makes you most self-fulfilled. You can check this out by asking yourself, "Is my life in good relationship with God?" According to Paul, giving is so much better than receiving. You've heard this in the past. What you sow is what you reap. 2 Corinthians 9:7 (NKJV) "So, let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God so loves a cheerful giver."

The seed faith principle in the Bible contains three simple keys: Recognize that God is your source. Give first, so that it may be given back to you. Expect a miracle.

Mark 11:24 says, "Whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them." The moment we ask God for something—the moment we do our part and plant our seed of faith—we should believe God that the answer is on its way. It's important to expect our miracle so we can recognize it and reach out to take it when it comes.:

When you're giving to the leaders in your church that are feeding you spiritually, sowing seems so much more effective,

Luke 63:8 (NKJV) "Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom, for with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

The vital kind of sowing besides financial, includes your bringing people to Jesus through salvation. You are rescuing the unbelievers and getting them ready to live in eternity. Don't forget, our care for others is the measure of our greatness.

The key to being funny is quite simple. Tell yourself as well as others that you not only have a great sense of humor, but you're great at telling jokes. Hold your hand out with your five fingers. Every time you speak one of these success principles, just bring down

one of your five fingers. These are the five success "P" secrets on how to tell great jokes. Avoid mentioning that this is a joke. Learn not to react to the wrong response.

- 2) Practice
- 3) Practice
- 4) Practice
- 5) Practice

In case you were curious, there is a subtle difference between laughter and humor. Laughter is an energy that can be shared while humor is subjective and not always shared. Thus, laughter is innate and humor is learned. I like to combine them. Use samples to practice such as Dean Martin Celebrity Roasts.

## 12. Patient Unity

One of the challenges in treating patients was that I didn't realize that many of their problems were unrelated to their medical situations. I learned that many doctor specialists reported that their patient's medical situations occurred "from the neck," that is, on an emotional basis.

So many were struggling to get rid of their bad habits and uncontrollable body and mind behaviors. They also need to develop good nutrition and exercise programs including positive attitudes. They also needed an entire transformation based on friendships and relationships with each other as a result of their love for God. Contradicting God is not a good idea, simply because it just doesn't work. God forms a spiritual covenant between us and our patients. To me this is sacred. The Meriam- Webster Dictionary defines covenant as a formal, solemn, and binding agreement. The Hebrew word for covenant is "to cut" because two people become in agreement through the cut bodies of slain animals. This is vital to understand since we are obligated in this profession to be servants and totally responsible through God to battle sickness and diseases, which is probably all brought on by the devil.

Here are some of the sayings I developed as a doctor and then as a doctor-reverend:

- 1) A hearty laughter is a good way to jog indoors without having to go outdoors. (This means laughing is like internal jogging.)
- 2) Either I will find a way to solve the problem, or I will make one.
- 3) Life is really ten percent of what happens to you and ninety percent of how you react to it.
- 4) What you do today can improve all your tomorrows.
- 5) Either you run the day, or the day runs you.
- 6) People don't need guns to survive, for their heaviest artillery is their will to live.
- 7) Women with strong emotions and barriers, can conquer their challenges by improving their attitudes. Sometimes word phrases help. TB (Tough Broad). One lady promoted herself to a TB, First Class. (Tough Bitch. Men can become an MBHG (Mind-Body-Heart Guard). In that way, their mind and heart guard their body.

To summarize, we must change and improve our attitudes, our thoughts, our belief systems, and our thinking habits. We also must appreciate that we all live in a world in which our feelings can become our slaves.

Our will determines our future. We only win when we "WILL" something instead of "WANT" something.

Make a difference by only speaking only positive words and thinking only positive thoughts. Here's a great start. Proverbs 13:3. (NKJV) "He who guards his mouth preserves his life, but he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction."

I love to attempt to live in the spiritual realm through the Holy Spirit. For example, whenever I insert an electrical plug into the socket, I just plug it in without checking to determine which is the correct side. It works. One of my favorite quotes is by Norman Cousins. "Death is not the greatest loss in life, but rather, the greatest loss is what dies inside us while we live." I went into the field of medicine to conquer sickness and disease, and amazingly, I found a supernatural pathway to accomplish this.

A doctor goes to a psychiatrist because he is possessed. He is totally delivered and healed over the course of a month. The psychiatrist sends him a bill but doesn't receive any response. He does these three more times and still no response. Since his bills are all totally ignored, the psychiatrist is forced to take the doctor to court. He wins the case, but the doctor continues to refuse to pay. Since the psychiatrist has no other options, he is forced to have the doctor repossessed.

### 13. The Unity of Our Healing Jesus

He reveals His compassion. Matthew 14:14. "And when Jesus went out, He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them and healed their sick."

He demonstrates healing is ours.

Matthew 15:22-28. "And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed." But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour."

Healing is in the atonement.

Isaiah 53:5. "But He was wounded for our transgressions,

He was bruised for our iniquities.

The chastisement for our peace was upon Him,

And by His stripes we are healed.

The glory of His father.

Matthew 15:30-31. "Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, [a]maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. 3 So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the [b]maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.

His mission

John 10:10. "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly."

Terminate the devil's works.

1 John 3:8. "He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil"

To protect us and defeat any adversary.

Luke 10:19. "Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

It heals and delivers us (Psalm 107:20).

It protects us (Psalm 18:30). It changes us into God's image (2 Corinthians 3:18).

It renews our mind (Romans 12:2).

It teaches us the truth and destroys lies. (2 Corinthians 10:4–5).

It comforts and consoles us (Psalm 119:50).

It is filled with promises and provides grace and mercy (Psalm 119:58).

It brings direction and what to do. (Psalm 119:133).

It endures forever being the good news (1 Peter 1:25: Mark 13:31).

A divorced woman reaches heaven after a challenging lifestyle and is greeted by St. Peter. ## 15. There Is Unity in Speaking in Tongues

There are more than 600 million Christians who have received the gift of the Holy Spirit, but most do not utilize this precious gift to the full potential. And many who speak in tongues on a regular basis who do not fully understand the benefits this gift brings.

I first heard about the miracles that can occur from speaking in tongues from hanging around Charles and Frances Hunter some ten years ago. They prepared for a long drive to a meeting that would require several hours and arrived in less than an hour. I also read that Pastor Patricia King had the same thing happen to her, but would you believe this was on a jet trip. It's called transplanted.

The truth is that speaking in tongues acts as the doorway to the supernatural glory of God. By increasing your time speaking in the Spirit, we can expect a greater measure of divine encounters in His presence that will refresh your walk with Him. There is power when we speak in tongues, and you will appreciate the experiences in His glory as you get more involved. I have spoke in tongues and witnessed people being healed.

Most of the information about speaking in tongues comes from the writings of the Apostle Paul. "I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all" (1 Corinthians 14:18). Please by-pass all the negative responses you hear because the rewards will be priceless. Speaking in tongues is really a heavenly language from God and this is confirmed as you talk to Him during your prayer language. Many people are so blessed to be able to understand what is being said regardless of the many different languages that are used.

According to the following Scripture, speaking in tongues becomes a person's language through the Holy Spirit: "For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries" (1 Corinthians 14:2). It's also used as a sign for unbelievers.

However, praying in tongues is not to be confused with speaking in tongues. The following happens so rarely. When a person sitting in church receives a prayer from God, he immediately communicates it to the congregation in tongues. At that point, another person in the church stands up and gives its interpretation. These messages are spoken in love to edify the church body.

For some reason, Jewish people always answer a question with a question. You'll find that Jesus did that in eight out of ten questions posed to him. I had a neighbor friend that lived next door to me that was always like that. "Abe, what are you doing today?" "What should I do?" "Abe, are you going away today?" "Where should I go?" One day, I asked the big question, "Abe, why do Jewish people always answer a question with a question?" He said, "Why not?"

## 16. Unity Is Not Living Together Unmarried

This routine substitute lifestyle reveals significant sociological evidence that demonstrates cohabitation is an inferior alternative to marriage. This relationship lacks profound changes such as unity, agreement, understanding, and, most importantly, love. You must live with the consequences when you live by seeing things with your head rather than with your heart. These commitments are much reduced between both parties. Catch the myths which exposes the truth.

1) This is a good way to "test the waters." This cohabitation test is more of a preparation for divorce according to the statistics. The relationships are fragile since they usually last an average of eighteen months.

2) That "piece of paper" means nothing. Living together lacks stability and offers little for those involved with their various levels of questionable commitment. Arrangements and verbal agreements are also pending. This kind of testing won't prevent the expenses and emotional trauma of a probable divorce. A strong bonding is required and unlikely to be developed for the partners who are attempting to maintain their needed relationship under stress and pressure. Living with someone else always fosters tension and anxiety throughout their relationship.

3) "Living together" automatically leads to marriage. Reports from college students today find that men cohabit simply because it's "convenient" without a true commitment. When women were questioned by a college professor about living together with men, they revealed an overwhelmingly positive. "We love each other, and we're learning how to be together." When the men were asked if they would marry the woman they were living with, the answer was simply, "No!"

4) "Living-together relationships" are better than marriage. When cohabiting relationships break up, both women and children suffer more poverty. Women contribute significantly more of their income to this relationship. There is a greater strain on the women because they must do more of the cleaning, cooking, and laundry. This strain will also affect her if she's a college student.

5) Here's a "personal opinion." After reading this far down, you need to seek God first before continuing in your non-marriage relationship. Determine if you are going to allow God to help you so you can find the right mate. He will let you know the one person He has chosen for you, including your new location, your work, and your finances.

Please realize that you are dealing here with anti-sexual unity. Multitudes of couples who have become so deeply involved with each other reach a point in their extended relationships where they can't figure out why they've stayed together so long despite challenges. The answer can be simply that the host of sexual chemicals that have affected their mind and their body during multiple orgasms have essentially addicted them to each other. Amen.

Mrs. Goldberg goes to heaven in her senior year and she is welcomed by St. Peter. He greets her with open arms and a big hug. He asks if there is anything, he could do for her? She requests she wants to talk with Mary, Jesus' mom. St. Peter informs her that Mary is on the other

side of heaven, but since her record on earth was so good going out of her way to pray for people and bring them salvation, he would make the necessary arrangements. The following morning Mrs. Goldberg is now sitting together with Mary. She says, "Mary, tell me seriously, were you happy with what your son Jesus did on earth? Mary says, "You know, Mrs. Goldberg, no one ever asked me that question, but to tell you the truth, I was extremely happy with what He did with His healings, His blessings to everyone, and especially His born-again activities. But to tell you the truth, I always wanted a doctor."

## 17. Unity in Marriage

The greatest blessings in our world, which would include our current day society, would be the total restoration of the family. With loving marriages both unstable families with divorces would be eliminated. A healthy family is built on the foundation of both the culture and connection of the married mother and father. Consider your spouse to be your closest friend, your greatest ally, your most bonded companion, and your covenant partner for life. God intended for two such people to become one. What happens seems simple. A man and a woman leave their father and mother and become united with each other as one flesh. When trials come with hard times, they need to continue to cleave (to be glued) to each other regardless of the circumstances. They continue to grow closer to each other by communicating and informing each other, "I'm with you, and I'll always love you." By the way, you can't have authority over people you don't love.

Consider these four foundational core values for a functioning marriage.

1) Be humble by putting your spouse first, that is, before yourself. In marriage, you come into a love relationship to basically lay down your life for one another. This sums it up well. Philippians 2:3–4. "Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others" A great marriage does require hard work, but you can't always expect to receive fun and happiness. Successful marriages are the result of daily choices and continuing to love each other. One of the keys is to do what your spouse wants you too even when you're not in the mood. Selective hearing loss is not an acceptable excuse. We can't relegate our love for a spouse to simply feelings. Marriage is really a covenant confirmed by the commitment of each other's love.

2) From a personal point of view, so many joyful married couples report that the greatest joys of life have been found in their marriage and their family. Jesus promised us joy, which is, of course is based on Him and all His promises. There is great joy in the way you can love your spouse and then to be totally blessed by their reaction to your passion.

3) Ask God to reveal ways you could do more in your life for your spouse. One consideration is to love more than you have in the past. And most important, continue to speak only positive words, for it will be accomplished.

4) Finally, allow Him to direct your paths each day so you can continue to be the kind of person He wants you to be. Ecclesiastes 9:9 "Live joyfully with the wife whom you love all the days of your vain life which He has given you under the sun, all your days of vanity; for that is your portion in life, and in the labor which you perform under the sun"

I know you're ready for this. Corinthians 7:1–4 "It is good for a man not to touch a woman. Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. Let the husband render to his wife the

affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise, the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does" in case you are having challenges with this spiritual law in your life, consider reading your Bible from now on because of so many hidden blessings.

## 18. Unity Is Blessed by Sex in Marriage

Medically speaking an orgasm involves a complex interaction between three systems of the body, the vascular, the nervous, and the endocrine systems. It's believed that it's pure miracle that they function so well together for they are part of the supernatural realm we are living in.

Here's an explanation of the seven chemicals involved.

1) Prolactin. Prolactin relieves sexual arousal. After the episode, the mind is removed from the event and one report states that the level then rises sharply thereafter. Your mind is then flooded with activities and chores you need to accomplish. That's prolactin at work.

2) Oxytocin. This is secreted by the pituitary gland, which stimulates the prostate gland, and causes muscle contractions, and sensitizes the nerves. This is known as the "cuddling hormone" because it causes you to feel a connection and bonding with your lover. It's also found in women's breasts.

3) Endorphins. They are a group of neurotransmitters formed within the body that bind to opiate receptors sites in your brain to relieve pain naturally. The biochemicals acetylcholine and dopamine are known as endorphins and have a similar chemical structure to morphine. They are also known to lower stress and boost confidence. Endorphins produce feelings of euphoria and pleasure, and they have a calming effect. They fill you with a sense of well-being and relaxation. Overstimulation of the opiate receptors causes a depressed sex drive. Sleep is not unusual. Endorphins are also released by the brain for almost any other exhilarating physical activity you may partake in.

4) Adrenaline (epinephrine). This activates the sympathetic nervous system, which increases the heart rate and dilates arteries to increase the blood flow to the muscles during sex. It also causes a refractory period so that another orgasm is impossible for up to twenty minutes after the initial sex act. During intercourse, increased amounts of adrenaline are released from the adrenal glands. This chemical amplifies the circulatory system with each heart contraction. This will cause the feeling of exhilaration with pounding of the heart out of the chest.

5) Phenylethylamine. This triggers the release of dopamine in the brain. This chemical is released during sex and peaks at orgasm. The response from this is described as overwhelming and is associated with feelings of bliss, attraction, and excitement. This chemical is also found in chocolate.

6) Testosterone. This fuels the sexual drive and aggression. It is essentially the libido and sexual arousal chemical. This causes you to feel turned on and sexually virile. A rush of confidence after sex can occur from increased testosterone at work. Men (and

women) with a testosterone deficiency often have difficulty getting aroused and have a reduced interest in sex.

7) Serotonin. This regulates moods. Having an orgasm releases an extra shot of serotonin to the brain, which acts as an anti-depressant. It makes you feel cheerful, hopeful, emotionally balanced, and content.

You can always get comic relief from Jesus. The pastor stops a church member walking by the church and says to him, "Have you given up drinking?" He hears, "Not yet." The pastor leads him to the garden to sit down at the swimming pool. He asks, "Are you ready to find Jesus?" And with that, the pastor places him into the pool and dunks his head under the water. He then releases him. The man begins to catch his breath, but not before the pastor asks him again, "Are you ready to find Jesus?" This time, he dunks his head under the water a much longer. When he releases the head of the man, head, the pastor says, "Well, did you catch Jesus who is here to help you?" The man responds, after he catches his breath by saying, "No, but are you sure this is where He fell in?"

## 19. Unity for personal Prayer

Once you develop a desire to pray daily, you no longer need to question yourself, "How's my prayer life going?" A great response can include, "It continues to improve." Prayer fuels the engine of your heart and mind and you already know the real and lasting value utilized through God. Pastor Andrew Wommack has already covered over praying.

1) When to pray. When over the need arises and you can be along with God. It's for the most important people in your life.

2) Before you speak, just listen for God is already aware of what you need. Prayer amounts to being in a conversation with Him for He hears you and speaks to you through His word, before you pray, read something and speak it out loud like from the Bible. Some prayer worriers let God have the first word. Then you can worship Him over and through His word. When you do this often enough, you won't have to question yourself if this is real.

3) Prioritize the spiritual and eternal needs over the circumstantial even though the physical needs are important. You're still battling against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. You're using precious time praying for the souls of others, the salvation of loved ones, the spread of the gospel, and the establishment of God's glory and His kingdom.

4) Stop and pray when necessary. When you receive the instinct to pray, respond immediately because it could well be the Holy Spirit prompting you.

5) Identify your circle of prayer partners and prioritize them. This should include your soul, your spouse, your family, small groups, your church, your nation, and even random strangers. Organize an emergency prayer package is vital. Having practice sessions is also a great idea.

6) It's okay to ask whatever you wish. Your so-called routine things must become your important prayer needs.

7. Ask one more time because God knows what's best for you.

8) Praying provides a confidence and strength nothing else will. There is communication between your heart, your mind, your spirit, and your God. Expect miracles for praying comes from the heart. The truth is, the more you allow God to use you, the more holy you become.

## 20. Unity in the power of prayer

There are as many ways of praying as there are people who do the praying. These prayer ministers are totally aware that dealing with overwhelming human circumstance is an ideal time to commune with a higher power. They take time seeking our conscious awareness of God. The spiritual level of our soul is heightened which provides strength, joy, and comfort.

As you begin to experience the presence of God expanding, prayer becomes part of Him, and we begin to center ourselves in the creative flow of the universe. That's when we start perceiving things from the divinity and sacred presence within us of Him. The purpose of prayer is to satisfy the natural longing in our souls and experience our creator and live from that understanding having oneness with God. True scarification only comes from finding God. The cofounder of Unity declared the real search for all people is for God.

In addition, when we pray, we receive a heartfelt invitation to allow God's life to be lived through us. Understandably, prayer has changed us. I believe prayer doesn't change things; prayer changes people, and people change things. Prayer becomes the way to express our thanks for life and its blessings. Again, prayer acknowledges the truth that God is present in us and in every situation and therefore the potential for us to beyond anything we can humanly imagine. Don't forget, prayers are to change us, not God. He is waiting for us to express our willingness to be guided and nurtured. Here's a way to consider. "Here I am God. Live your life through me." This is an amazing capture of an article on Prayer by Mary-Alice and Richard Jafolla.

Two New Zealand pilots began praying when they ran out of fuel in a microlight airplane. They were able to make an emergency landing in a field coming to rest right next to a sign reading, "Jesus is Lord." Jesus is always the answer.

## 21. Unity Explains any level of Faith

When we learn to use our faith even in a small manor, like

Jesus stated in Luke 12:28, "Oh, you of little faith." He's complimenting you because He's really saying to you. "Little faith is not so bad." You can still do great things by just applying your faith as a seed you plant. Great miracles can occur from God as you progress to a better life. Except for two phenomenal people, the truth is that most of the people Jesus dealt with had little faith. Jesus performed some of the greatest miracles through people who had little faith. God has given every human being a part of His own great faith. The Apostle Paul said in Romans 12:3, "For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith"

The truth is that the amount of faith you have is not as important as the truth that your faith is given to you by God. It's not the size of your faith, but the one who is behind your faith. The Apostle Paul states that the seed of faith we sow is the starting point for a miracle. God makes it happened since He is the source of our faith. 2 Corinthians 9:10: "Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness"

Even if your faith is a tiny seed that you put it in, it's something you give, something you do to show your love and concern. The one you do it unto is God. Your power is in God who multiples your sowing. However, when

you do need to use your faith, catch this from 2 Timothy 4:2: "Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching" Do this whether you feel like it or not.

Again, hold onto your so-called little faith, for this faith is the God of miracles. This is how you will be able to get needs met in your life. Your faith will become the seed you plant. If you ever feel you are just about out of faith, just tell yourself, "I will never doubt the power of my little faith." All of us exercise faith every day, at least in other people. Atheists are not unbelievers. They're just people who choose to put their faith in men instead of God. It takes more faith to not believe in God than it does to believe in Him.

Here's an opportunity to learn a valuable lesson that things are not always what you think. Several years ago, a plane was unexpectedly diverted to another city and the passengers were given an option to get off during the one-hour delay. A woman passenger remained which the captain recognized as his blind friend and frequent flyer. He asked if he could be of service and she thought her seeing-eye dog would like to stretch his legs. All the people in the entire gate came to a sudden stop when they saw the pilot, wearing sunglasses, walk off the plane with a seeing-eye dog and wearing

sunglasses. This true story was confirmed by the previous passengers who attempted to change planes and even airlines.

## 22. Unity with Children

When you raise children, you must look forward to exhilarating challenges that are clarifying and confusing, frustrating and freeing. Trial and error do not fall into the category of any known magic formulas since there aren't any. Consider the following helpful principles.

1) By being persistent, avoid reacting to any personal mood. Establish the same, identical response to their actions, regardless of your feelings. For example, your child begins to scream for candy in the store, have a prepared response instead of giving in just because you're tired or in a hurry. They can't learn that their behavior will help them get their way.

2) Your yelling is inappropriate. In that way they won't have to listen because your angry. The bottom line is that you have their best interests in mind.

3) Given them choices teaches your kids how to think. If they're making too much noise in the living room, you might say, "Wouldn't you rather play in your room?"

4) Correct attitudes are vital. Their behavior comes from their thoughts which are manifested as their attitudes. Direct them toward an appropriate action.

5) Be patient as they grow up because. they are incapable of precise thinking and do dumb things when they're younger. While they're developing, reassure them and yourself rather than punishing them.

6) The principle of first mention is too often neglected. The first-time they hear about any subject it's received as the truth. The second time they hear about the same thing, they may reject it. Don't wait to tell them about important things, for example, like sex, until they're fifteen. They may reject what you said because it's the opposite of what they have already heard.

7) Allow them to learn as they're growing. If they do something wrong and there are no significant consequences, let them experience it. They learn more from their mistakes than from their successes.

8) Avoid comparisons by comparing them to other children so they don't become an imitation of someone else. You want your children to be who God created them to be.

9) Speak positively persistently. They become what you say and speak because death and life is in the power of the tongue (Proverbs 18:21). Their behavior is not who they are. This reminds me of the dog wearing a coat on his back that reads: "My name is Bad Dog. What's yours?"

10) Believe in your children because they can become anything they want to in life. You need to become their biggest fan, their cheerleader, and their catalyst to greatness.

11) Resolve conflicts by allowing them to let you watch you. Allow them to observe you because every healthy relationship has its struggles.

12) Affection in your home is so important. This includes being loving with your spouse, your children, even in their teen years, including hugging and kissing, so they learn what love looks like.

13) Honor others again by speaking positively about leaders, authority figures, and adults so your children can live successfully in society and have a healthy respect for other people.

14) Let your children "catch" you loving on Jesus especially while your praying on your knees. Get them to see both of you reading the Bible, for example, on the living room couch every day. This sends a powerful visual statement revealing your value of value of spiritual things. People are changed through observation, not by argument.

15) Handling money is significant for them to learn how to be generous, and how to trust God with their money. This will enable them to steward finances and create wealth.

16) Giving should be a family secret rather than a secret from the family. They need to be taught between two choices because one of them will become their master. They can serve God or they can serve money.

### 23. Unity Is Needed by Many People in Many Countries

What needs to be included in the unity program, and desperately needed, are the Lord's people in the many countries throughout the world who are suffering. These are the Christians who are experiencing discrimination, harassment, and violence. The 2018 booklet from Barnabas Aid titled "Praying for the Persecuted Church" reveals the devastating conditions for all those people currently living in some fifty countries and fighting daily to survive.

An important part of their strength is received from the blessings of powerful Scripture from Psalm 118:17. "Your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard" Isaiah 58:8. "Do not be wise in your own eyes: fear the Lord and depart from evil" (Proverbs 3:7). "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord."

During my summer vacation from Albright College, I applied and received the opportunity to work in a hospital as a scrub nurse. I took a few days off with the permission of my OR Supervisor who was a tremendous lady. I decided to go to the beach. The weather was excellent, and I had perfect relaxation time. At the beach, I saw a postcard in the bookstore with a picture of a beautiful girl in a bathing suit. I decided to send it to my operating room supervisor like I wanted to thank her. I wrote on the back of the card, "Having a wonderful time. Wish you were her." She never said anything to me, but when I got back, I saw the card pinned to the OR corkboard outside her office.

I started on a new diet: Limburger cheese, garlic, and onions. I didn't lose any weight, but I sure looked good from a distance.

I was taking care of a mother in the office, and her little girl was with her. I asked her daughter, "Do you guys pray before you eat?"

She said, "Oh no, my mom's a good cook."

## 24. Smiling Together Promotes Unity

Ever wonder about the awesome power of a smile, look at the Mona Lisa. Smiling is one of the world's greatest facial gestures. It's a symbol rated with the highest positive emotional content. Smiling occurs from the contraction of our facial muscles with an obvious happiness just like exercising induces. It produces the same positive effects from the chemicals enkephalins and endorphins, which are opiate receptors in the central nervous system. Smiling changes our brain activity by reducing stress, lowering blood pressure, stimulating the immune system, and generating positive emotions. Just like laughter, children demonstrate four hundred smiles on an average a day, while us non-children (adults) do it maybe twenty times a day. A famous yearbook study revealed women who smiled the most had fewer setbacks, had happier lives and marriages, and lived longer lives. You already realize that smiling can be learned. Before you engage in a telephone conversation, visualize the event producing a deeper satisfaction and joy just by smiling. By the way, people can always tell if you have a smile on your face even without seeing you. Our brain uplifts our spirits through God, which produces a burst of positive chemicals already mentioned and responsible for these changes.

While standing in front of a mirror, move the muscles involving your eye sockets and corners of your mouth. You will immediately appreciate its effects because you will feel not only more relaxed but happier. So, you can change your day simply by smiling, but more often by doing it in front of everyone and everything. One of the keys to its success is to practice and keep getting comfortable with it. Smiling can become contagious just by reciprocating. A smile from a stranger could be a friend you haven't met yet. It could also be an angel.

Here's another wonderful "shortcut blessing." Even though you don't know a person, when they sneeze, say to them, "God bless you!"

Don't be surprised if the Holy Spirit tells you to do this because this is a person who truly need this kind of loveable blessing. Did you realize that people living together live longer when they touch, hug, kiss, and hold hands frequently? These activities result in the reduction of stress among other emotionally improved conditions.

This is one of my crazy activities I think about, but I has never done before. You're standing outside the elevator, waiting for the doors to open. When it does, you wait so that you're the last person to enter. As soon as you do, you remain facing the crowd instead of turning around. Then you speak to the people so that everyone can hear you. You speak out loud and say, "I guess you're all wondering why I invited you here today?" Then before you get a response, you ask "Is there anybody here who wants to be sure to go to Heaven?" You might to prepare for this by practicing your anticipated response with close friends. You can also pass out a spiritual flyer or your business card and have them call you for those who are too busy. Incidentally there are programs in malls answering questions about going to heaven.



A bank robbery takes place in the Old West, and the sheriff and his posse take off to apprehend the thief. He's been identified by one of the bank tellers, and he is captured later that night when the fire from his campsite exposes him. He is surrounded by the sheriff and his posse.

After they search him, it's obvious he has hidden the money. The sheriff threatens him that unless he reveals where he buried the cash, they are going to hang him right there.

He doesn't respond because one member of the posse, Gomez, recognizes him and realizes that he doesn't understand English. Gomez translates the question, and the robber tells him exactly where the money is. The sheriff asks Gomez, "Where did he tell you the money is?" Gomez says, "He told me, he not afraid to die."

## 25. People Love Doctors, Especially When There Is Unity between Them

The human body experiences a powerful gravitational pull in the direction of hope when seeking or entering a physician's office. I did see many medical conditions respond to my medical school training, but it was so disappointing not to be able to heal, but only treat the symptoms of so many medical conditions. It was disappointing. That's why I began to realize in my practice that my patients' greatest hopes were really a physician's secret weapon. This became the hidden ingredient in any prescription until their prognosis was given. A patient's prognosis is defined as the prospect of recovery as anticipated from the usual course of disease or peculiarities of the case. However, I did see many medical conditions respond to the treatments I learned in medical school, even though there were limitations.

The greatest danger to a patient is when their prognosis is ad-libbed by their doctor without any scientific confirmation. The physician's explanation of the patient's prognosis is becoming more and more of a prophecy, without any divine intervention. Yet medically, they really can't see into the future. There are Christian doctors who have demonstrated healings (we never use the words "miracle" or "cure" in medicine) of their patients through their godly relationship with Jesus. But the question is, why have so many patients become so disappointed with

their doctor's care. The reason is obvious. They now receive negative words as the doctor attempts to explain their medical condition, though it's mostly a guess, which, unfortunately, excludes any hope.

Why are doctors failing to adequately serve their patients? Again, precious, dedicated doctors are giving negative prognoses for their patients' medical conditions without providing any hope or reassurance, which has instead been replaced with negativity. The major challenge here is that patients believe what they're told by their treating physician. Today, the patient's greatest challenge is being forced to listen to their doctor's interpretation of what will happen to them with their disease or sickness. When you realize sickness or disease has been caused by demonic forces, there is immediate hope for a cure just by casting those forces out in the mighty name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth. That is, I rebuke that. Of course, I never heard about this in medical school.

Incidentally, I recently found a great definition of a doctor: a "wise man." Let's keep it that way. We were always taught to tell the truth. I never knew there was an alternative to overcoming sickness and disease by using the supernatural realm. There is, however, a profound difference between truth and facts. Facts are not reliable, for they constantly change. That's exactly why, when a patient receives a diagnosis, it's inappropriate. It's a curse because the patient's authority is in Jesus. You can't label a person with any

sickness or disease because, when Jesus died on the cross, He took every one of these medical conditions on Himself as God's servant. This means the truth is that there can't be anything wrong with your patient. By this understanding, they can't have any diagnoses or medical labels. The Bible states that "by His stripes, we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5).

The final point here is that since there are no sicknesses or diseases in Heaven, how can they exist in us? You can only find them in the medical textbooks. By the way, I too had to believe all this medical information away from medical school and continue to apply it during the early days of my practice. It took me what I thought was forever to accept the supernatural realm (which came before the natural realm) and then learn how to reject the latter. That is, until I got healed of chronic intractable pain. But when I began to see many miracles and cures, I never saw or believed before, I realized I had discovered a better way of blessing people through the Holy Spirit.

Here's a quick example that does not come under the category of being a

"show off." I was recently requested to appear on our local TV station with a young woman afflicted with cancer whom I had ministered to on the telephone and whom Jesus had healed. That day, I received several requests from the television audience for healing. As a result, Jesus later healed scoliosis, high blood pressure, rheumatoid arthritis, traumatic contusion of the shoulder, plantar fasciitis, diabetes, and arthritis.

There are a growing number of people who are not spiritually trained but who want to be involved with healing and deliverance. Here's where the doctors can make a profound difference just by speaking only positive words about the outcome of their patients' conditions now that they have an alternative. That's why I referred to my practice as Alternative Medicine Healing Ministry, and Jesus remains in charge. This is the only alternative.

Doctors need to understand that the best and ideal answers for healing exist in the supernatural realm. If a doctor is opposed to learning about healing, they need to refer their untreatable patients to someone who does want to learn. This will happen with the prophecy that is referred to as "the camels are coming." I have witnessed many patients healed with the diagnosis of cancer through Jesus. This also includes conditions like chronic intractable pain. You would think a doctor would have no difficulty learning how to perform healing after spending thousands of hours in medical school. The truth is that when their attitude is such that this becomes the desire of their heart, it will be quick and easy to learn and for them to become dedicated. The bottom line is that their attitude must be the control center of their life.

I am also aware of testimonies in which prayer cloths have been placed on different parts of a sick patient's body and these anointed cloths have caused patients to be healed by the Holy Spirit. A young man was involved in a serious motor vehicle accident

that rendered him comatose and required a respirator. His prognosis was poor, and his doctors eventually decided to turn off the respirator. The family heard about this decision and arrived the following morning accompanied by a well-known pastor, who ministered to this patient. Everyone was shocked to watch the patient move and even start talking. He immediately wanted to know from his doctors why, when he heard that the respirator was to be turned off, no one heard him yelling, "Don't turn off the respirator! I'm still alive. Help me!" There are many such testimonies.

It's very difficult not to be judgmental about the negativity because that's how doctors inform their patients of what they believe is the truth to come. It turns out to be their personal truth and not reliable. How can doctors tell patients what they know will happen without spiritual experience? The patient's only hope has been taken from them. And worse, they've been informed about what will happen to them based on the doctor's so-called experience, which can't be good. They are really speaking what will happen into existence. It's a terrible punishment. Instead, we need to determine every possible spiritual treatment that's available, which means the patient needs to be referred to Jesus. This is confirmed in the Bible, which is difficult to accept since most of us are only using our secular knowledge rather than God's way in the supernatural realm. There are far too many testimonies of patients (famous ones) who committed suicide when they were told what is referred to here as the doctor's truth. I too struggled with those permanent changes regarding my chronic feet pain, since my brain had been washed in my subconscious mind to what was untruth.

Here's the last testimony. My long-time pastor friend was admitted to the emergency room with significant chest pain. He was found to have a ruptured aortic aneurysm after medical testing. (Did you notice that I didn't call this his "diagnosis"?) As you can imagine the doctor's decision was to inform him directly, "You're going to die!" He fought the doctor's negative comments and won. What happened is that God took him to Heaven during the operation in his natural body and returned him in his spiritual body, totally healed. The doctor, in turn, wrote a note on a prescription confirming his patient's miracle.

We must realize that we are not in competition with Jesus. Eventually, after witnessing so many miracles for many years, I became a retired Jewish-Christian neurosurgical healing evangelist. One of the great blessings I discovered is that being an evangelist is the key to developing friendships. The spirit of the Lord is saying that He knows the end and it's going to be okay because "I am your God. I will never leave you, nor forsake you, and all your challenges can be resolved through me." 56

The pastor was ministering to his church and asked, "Is there anyone else who needs healing before we finish praying and leave the church?" Harry raised his hand and was instructed to come down to the front. The pastor asked him, "What does your condition involve?"

Harry said, "Hearing."

The pastor laid his hands-on Harry's ears and ministered to him for three minutes. When he finished, he said to Harry, "How is your hearing now?"

Harry said, "I don't know. It's not until next Wednesday."

Please allow me to point out that there are many diseases that people don't have to live with because they don't realize that Jesus can heal them, for example, COPD, MS, IBS, and CA, etc. This confirms that Jesus has a sense of humor, as He can heal letters. This includes every aspect of your healing. If people would just open their hearts, they wouldn't get stuck fighting euthanasia or worrying about hospice. Did you know that in many hospitals outside our country, a believer can minister to multiple patients with their permission and clear the hospital of sick patients? It doesn't happen here in our country because of the overpowering control of the demonic spirits.

The truth is that every believer can be a miracle worker or a healer through Jesus. Just decide to become a world changer in the spiritual realm for Jesus Christ of Nazareth. This is what you may have been created to be in these end days. You can then demonstrate the Kingdom on earth as it is in Heaven so that you will then walk in signs, wonders, and miracles, which will become "normal Christianity" for you and anyone else who wants to be involved. Here's the secret to getting healed: You + me (any believer) + God = the majority.

Why will God heal you?

- 1) He loves you as much as He loves anyone else.
- 2) He has compassion for your hurts and wounds.
- 3) He wants you healed.
- 4) He's doing the same thing today as He did in Bible days.
- 5) He has given you faith to believe for your healing. The truth is that God has already given you the authority to be healed because He lives in you, so you don't have to wait for him. Creflo Dollar made a great observation, Stop talking to God about your problem; instead talk to your problem because God is in charge helping you.

Here's a recent prophesy I received that "blew my mind." "You know you've done so many things in your life, being a neurosurgeon for seventy-one years. You really brought a lot of help to patients even when you didn't know me," said the Lord. "You brought healing, always in your hands. What you didn't understand is that I had healing in your hands from the time you were a very young man. But see, you thought it had to be supernatural all the time."

Why not personalize Psalm 91 for yourself by memorizing it and speaking it before you go to bed and when you wake up. Make it an awesome blessing for it will provide the needs of your life. As you continue to get closer to Jesus, you'll want to be able to abide in Him without question so that He will become your place of permanent residence. In case you didn't realize it, He's already living in you when you were born again and received the prayer of salvation.

"Is this Rabbi Cohen?"

## 27. Unity Through the Power of Psalm 91

He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress; my God, in Him will I trust." Surely, He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence, He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler. You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you. Only with your eyes shall you look and see the reward of the wicked. Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, even the Most High, your dwelling place, no evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; for He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone. You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot. Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will set him on high, because he has known My name. He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. With long life I will satisfy him and show him My salvation.

Psalm 91 promises the following blessings to you:

- 7) Angelic protection will keep you in all your ways.
- 8) You will prevail against all enemies.
- 9) God will deliver you and set you on high as you set your love upon Him.
- 10) God will answer your prayers.
- 11) He will be with you in times of trouble.
- 12) He will deliver you.
- 13) He will bless you with longevity.
- 14) You will be saved!

Claim these promises as your own because God wants you to believe them, receive them, and walk upon and with them. Take your stand upon God's word. As a Psalm 91 Christian, you already realize you will be exceedingly blessed in every way!

## 28. Unity with God

The reason is that He needs people to become a vessel so that He can flow through us. We are now in a special generation to see the glory of God which is His doxa or reputation. In other words, He wants His reputation to flow through us. God has more hope in us than we do in ourselves.

As far as His word is concerned, you are His child, and you became so when Jesus died. That's why we have the authority of Jesus. You could say we are compensating and filling in for Jesus when necessary since He died on the cross. You already know that Jesus already paid the price for everything that we've done wrong when He was nailed on the cross. This was given to us by grace (unmerited favor), the gift of righteousness. According to God, everything we've ever done is now perfected because Christ in us is the hope of glory. Yet the devil attempts to step in and disrupt us in every possible way. We need to grasp the truth that it's not God, but the devil who has entered the playground of our mind.

Here's a spiritual revelation not identified by most people. Proverbs 20:27. "The spirit of man is the candle of the Lord, searching all the inward depths of his heart." Have you heard people tell you they have a "gut feeling" about an upcoming situation? This means it's the Holy Spirit who is involved because that's where He lives. Intuition is really a great sign of intelligence. Research has revealed that people who do follow their "gut feelings" often make better decisions. When you embrace Jesus because of your continued talking, reading, thinking, and mentioning of Him, you will begin to feel His presence as He comes to be by your side. He will become even closer to you than your very breath because He lives in you as you live in Him. Therefore, you will know Him better than anyone else. His presence through your personal Bible will cause you to need Him more and more, especially through prayer. This is no different than when your body needs special kind of food and you realize you yourself need this spiritual kind of food. Did you know that a Bible that is worn out is always owned by a person who isn't? (Charles Haddon Spurgeon, 1834-92.)

### 30. Unity with Laughter

Laughter is an energy, a spirit; it's really a sixth sense. The power of laughter is so great it needs to be appreciated by everyone. Its response is immense! It operates in the body through the chemicals, the enkephalins and endorphins, providing that necessary feeling of wellbeing. It also reduces loneliness, among many other conditions. Laughter is like sunshine because it will brighten your day. It's also the music of the heart which makes it an exceptional form of power.

The reason it's so effective from a spiritual point of view is that when you joke, you're involved in healing. The devil realizes that you are "on to him," for he is responsible for the illness. The person being ministered to also understands and joins in with the fun despite the significance of the medical situation. This attitude reduces the seriousness of the condition because Jesus already revealed the truth that there is nothing wrong in laughter. Here's the key from Proverbs 17:22. "A merry heart does good, like medicine, but a broken spirit dries the bones" Laughter crosses denominational lines. There are many testimonies of people who are "slain" in the spirit (fall under the power) and bounce out of this with tremendous laughter. The next thing you know, they want to become an evangelist. Laughing transforms their life. They recommit their lives to Jesus because of the spiritual nature of all of this. This satisfies their longing for peace, especially when Jesus heals them. Regardless of what you believe about your ability to tell jokes, you simply have to understand that you already have the power in your tongue to do this; you just have never practiced it.

Catch this. Learn the importance of the five "P's" about telling great jokes. P stands for "Practice." Do this by telling jokes to yourself while standing in front of your bathroom mirror with the lights on and the door locked. Stick your fingers out in the mirror. As you speak the word practice, bring each of your five fingers separately down touching your palm. Also, practice with your friends. You'll realize when you tell a great joke from their response. You will gain confidence and credibility practicing like this. If they don't laugh, don't react. Move on and think, "Who's next." Store the jokes in your mind that receive the best response, for they will become your repertoire. When you tell a joke, introduce it as a story rather than as a j. By the way, there is no such thing as too much practice.

Charlie Chaplain believed that a day without laughter is a wasted day. Get Jesus to help you reinforce your comedic abilities. You can and will speak this into existence.

My next-door neighbor told me he had just found out that his wife's credit card had been stolen. Then he found out the name of the guy who took it, but he said he wasn't going to report him. I asked him, "Why not?" He said, "The guy is spending less money than my wife ever did!"

### 31. God's Unity Resolves Loneliness and Insomnia

The eternal quest of many individual human beings is to shatter their loneliness. "It is not good that man should be alone" (Genesis 2:18). Research has revealed that loneliness can lead to several dysfunctional responses, including increased blood pressure and the production of inflammatory-related proteins. Not only do they miss people also react more strongly to stressful situations. Loneliness affects our health and sleep and causes disruptions during the night. This condition is known to spread like a virus among people. They can't miss prayer which will make a difference. Isaiah 42:1. "Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand." Say this often enough to make a difference and keep thanking the Lord. Avoid insomnia, write a complete to-do list for the next day. Just open the Bible up anywhere and read (the Lord will intervene). Say this prayer. Proverbs 3:24. "When you lie down, you will not be afraid; Yes, you will lie down, and your sleep will be sweet").

Here are seven ways to consider overcoming loneliness:

- 1) Reach out to others and join groups with similar interests as yours.
- 2) Get to know yourself better.
- 3) Talk to someone new when you're out and about.
- 4) Spend less time on technology, and more time in the real world.
- 5) Ask yourself if your feelings represent reality or not,

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## 32. The Unity of Scripture Will Sanctify Us

Sanctification is God's will for us. When you "sanctify" a person, you make him holy, which is related to the word "saint." One of the greatest blessings we have been given is to speak the actual word of God, which is the same as speaking scriptural verses. An easy method for memorizing them is to just repeat the verses often enough during your personal training.

### 34. Unity Challenges with Soul Ties

Godly soul and spiritual ties develop when you bond with people you love, especially with your husband or wife, your family, etc. One of the greatest examples of a soul tie in the Scriptures is described by 1 Samuel 1:18. "Now when he had finished speaking to Saul, the soul of Jonathan was knit to the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul"

At the extreme opposite end is the ongoing damage that occurs in our souls as a result of our fleshly relationships. When you have sexual relations with another person, neurochemical changes occur in both brains that encourage limbic, emotional bonding. The limbic system is one part of our brain that deals with and regulates emotions, memory, and sexual arousal. When it is not working properly, you will have feelings of depression and lethargy. Limbic bonding is the reason casual sex doesn't really work for most people, as it involves their whole mind and body. Sex outside marriage is enhancing an emotional bond between them and their partner whether they want it or not. When a woman forms an attachment, she will be hurt more when a casual affair ends because her limbic system is larger than the male's.

Unhealthy soul ties are often the ramifications of creating lifelong bonds through sexual encounters, and they can form even though the relationships are only short term. The kind

of soul tie that remains long after the relationship is over leaves both sexual partners longing for wholeness. Ungodly soul ties can involve any fleshly, unbalanced relationship, for example, bonding with alcohol, cults, drugs, etc., and they lead the person who has them down an ungodly path.

Here's a model prayer you can say aloud so the devil can hear you and be forced to free you from any captive association because of your dominion and authority in Christ. "Jesus, I forgive (the name of the person) for what has happened in my past, for what (the name of the person) has done and has not done. I forgive him or her, and I forgive myself as well for any part that I have played in all this. I now put (the name of the person) into my hands (cup your hands) along with any bad, tormenting feelings that I have been carrying toward (the name of the person). This includes hurt, bitterness (drinking a cup of poison and expecting the other person to die), anger, resentment, rejection, sadness, betrayal, disappointment, abandonment, or any kind of influence that has developed since this relationship began. I cancel all psychic activity and all ungodly soul ties that may exist between others and myself."

A patient comes to my office to inform me she is suffering with amnesia. I immediately ask her, "How long have you had this?"

She says to me, "How long have I had what?"

Goliath's mom was upset with her son because he never listened to her. She told him to stop going out with David because he kept coming home stoned.

### 35. God's Unity without Hate

In our culture, one way to respond to someone telling you to go to "H" is to ask them if that means them Honduras?" Then you tell them to go to Heaven?" (My "H." I can tell you there is a dangerously thin line between the words hate and love. Both emotions share an incredibly important common denominator—intense passion. The result causes us to do vastly different things. The most important question is, with such a thin line, is it possible to turn hate around into love? The answer is can you make the decision.

Be healthy by reducing hate to zero. Did you realize that when you're nicer, your stress levels are reduced? Decreasing hate also supports a healthier mental status. Hate exacerbates stress. This is believed to be a huge factor in developing many illnesses, like insomnia and digestive disorders. This also includes deadly medical situations like cancer. Healthier minds and bodies increase healthier relationships, which improves your spiritual and physical levels.

You receive longer life with reduced hate. Oxytocin, a brain chemical, reduces free radicals (atoms causing aging, heart disease, and cancer) in the body and inflammation, which slows down aging (David R. Hamilton, Ph.D.) A study conducted on Tibetan Buddhists found kindness and compassion reduces inflammation in the body. It was found that the vagus nerve can control compassion in the body.

Love and kindness. Turn hatred into love—or kindness (Dr. Hamilton)—our brain releases dopamine and endogenous opioids, which can improve mood and give a natural high.

Kinder people are more successful and when they are genuinely kinder and compassionate, they are the most successful (David Books, New York Times). We already have an incentive to repay kindness with kindness. Children who performed acts of kindness gained an average of 1.5 friends over a four-week period (Psychology Today).

Creativity and kindness work together. New research has found a connection between art and kindness (Centre for the Study of Group Processes at the University of Kent). There is a potential for the arts to be at the center of our heart to strengthen our capacity for empathy, friendship, social bonds, and concern for others, including future generations.

Here are some great recommendations:

- \* Helping others helps ourselves by making us feel better.
- \* Meditate by yourself. Find quiet times a few minutes a day to find ways to eliminate stored hatred and do this frequently.

\* Think of someone you love and then attempt to consider the difficulty to believe that love and hate can't co-exist in the same mind. Then think of your spouse, someone very special, even a pet, or your favorite music.

\* Stay current with your life. Your "unconscious" mind may trigger memories from your past. So, stay in the present and screen your thoughts and feelings, which may no longer be currently relevant.

\* Do you really hate is a vital question. Reevaluate your feelings since your hatred of things can be based on past experiences that have already changed.

\* Love without the hate. The thin line between these two can potentially exist together, like in marriage. Usually, one is more dominant. You both love each

other, but the hate may exist more as anger and being extremely irritated. Decide to ignore your negative attitudes. If you do make a mistake by speaking a negative word, "hate," simply holler, "Cancel, cancel!" Then rebuke what you said because this is all related to demonic activity that was probably within you but is going to leave.

\* Be open to receive love. Lack of being loved on a personal basis can cause this. Unnecessary hate. Start hanging around nice people and begin loving on them so they can reciprocate with you. For example, became a volunteer at an animal shelter or purchase a pet, like a dog. One of the most beautiful spiritual expressions of love is the adoption of a baby.

\* Proper food habits are necessary. The word "diet," to me, doesn't mean the word "die" without the "t". Eat healthier, avoid processed sugar, flour, caffeine, soda, fried foods, etc. Just drinking water is so vital. Take your weight and divide it in half to give you the number of ounces you require daily, A lot of weight gain is related to laziness. It's a battle between the food monster and the food police. I went to a beach where there was a scale that gave you your fortune. When I read the weight card, that came out, it read, "Come back in ten minutes, alone!"

A lady came running into the bar and shouted to the bartender, "Give me something quick for the hiccups." He ran out of the bar and hit her with a wet mop. She hollered, "No, it's not for me. It's for my husband. He's in the car!"

One of the most common questions we asked one another as we scheduled to graduate from Carnegie Hall. was, "How do you get to Carnegie Hall?"

The obvious answer is, "Graduate from medical school." The other answer is, "Take the Fifth Avenue Bus."

### 36. Unity Gets Stronger as Evil Gets Weaker

When I was first exposed to this secular world, I was overwhelmingly preoccupied with all the school activities related to medicine. I ignored it since none of it made any sense. I would even joke about the word evil and let my friends know about my feelings by reversing its spelling now meant live. I did realize that preaching against it made little difference to any of the people who are already addicted. My impression is that there is a constant battle with those struggling to attempt to free themselves. As you, the devil is doing everything he can to destroy our yielding to God. These challenges include abortion, homosexuals, lesbians, unmarried couples living together, pedophiles, guilt (a gift that keeps on giving), adultery (the greatest form of disloyalty), same-sex marriage, discrimination, pornography, cults, idolatry, physical and/or sexual abuse, rape, immoral acts, fear (false evidence appearing real), cheating, lying, prostitution, alcohol, drugs, hatred, envy, transgenders, murder, blasphemy (insulting God), polygamy, concubines, warfare, unbelief, stealing, lying, unforgiveness, rebellion, etc.

Listen to this: it really doesn't matter what you've done wrong because Jesus has already taken your sins from you when He went to the cross. Luke 23:34 is quite clear that He has totally forgiven you." This is what He spoke after being nailed to the cross: "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they do." His blood that cleanses us all.

We totally underestimate demonic forces because the devil wants to destroy us through his brainwashing tactics. You already realize that we are at war with the devil. He has assigned seven thousand demons against every one of us. Here's a great summary of explaining both the devil's and Jesus's goals. John 10:10. "The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly" (John 10:10).

We have this authority through the Lord because we received this power when we became children of God. So, you understand that when we do the praying, He does the recovery. Here's the truth. When people are willing to give up their unholy intellect, both signs and wonders will bring people into the Kingdom because only God's power can change us.

You can handle the devil's attacks against you when you realize you need to take charge. You torment the devil simply by loving God when you sing about Jesus and worship Him. The devil obviously wants both attention and to be worshiped. Here's another method of overcoming his desires is to just totally ignore him and remain silent. This is a winning formula.

Here's a precious story about the awesome evangelist Smith Wigglesworth from a female member of his church. She said, "I kept having these dreams about the devil and finally told a brother from my church. I told him how scared I was of the devil, and He responded, "Don't be." Then he said, "The devil does not have power over you, and he

can be defeated just by you saying and speaking the name of Jesus.' Then he told me a story of the devil appearing to Smith Wigglesworth. One night, when he rolled over, he saw Satan sitting on his bed, and he said to him, "Oh, it's just you." And he turned back over and went to sleep. Well, that night, I was so scared that my husband had to escort me to the bathroom."

Learn to use the powerful name of Jesus when you're really in trouble. This young girl was taking a shower when she was suddenly startled as the curtain was pulled back. A tall man with a beard, wearing a long coat, was standing before her. She immediately cried out, "Devil, I rebuke you! I command you to leave me now in the name of Jesus. Whoever you are, Jesus wants you out of here now! Leave now, or he's going to have to hurt you. I command you to leave now, or you're going to have to protect yourself. Take your body and your mind and leave in the name of Jesus right now." This is a true story, as are other similar testimonies of those in trouble.

James 5:16 is a great Scripture to get a friend's help: "Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (The truth is, the closer you walk with God, the more trials you'll have with the devil, but this is all part of God's training program for you to get stronger. You already know the devil hates the word of God even though he knows the Bible. Incidentally, did you know that the Bible is the bestselling book in the world? (Sixteen billion sold.) The devil is headed for the bottomless pit, where one of his biggest disappointments will be that he is no longer able to use all his counterfeit activities and tools.

When people take control of their mind and heart without God, they demonstrate all kinds of potential evil activities. God doesn't control our minds but gives us the freedom to think. When you think about this, it can be scary because, without God, you can easily lose control. He wants us to fill our minds with His truth, but the choice is still up to us. Don't forget, you can always rebuke your own thoughts, especially if they're from the devil.

The reason Satan was forced to leave Heaven was simply that he wanted to be God and to "kick God off His throne." Sin, a capital offense, thus entered God's creation, dragging along death as its consequence. The devil uses bullets that are sin. If it's not of God, it's of the devil, for God only knows how to do good, not evil. It's interesting how the words "good" and "God" almost match one another except for the extra "o."

There are only two laws involved here. the law of life in Christ and the law of sin and death. The knowledge of the truth will set you free, and as overwhelmed as you may be from hearing this again and again about the devil, yes, even more times than you want to count, you need to believe you can easily overcome his power. Being obedient is so



vital. Moses was told to speak to the rock to release the water, but instead, he ignored God by striking the rock. Obeying God requires agreement on a lifetime basis, but it bestows continued success in any of your endeavors. God punished Israel for their sin for failing to trust and obey Him. They were sentenced to forty years in the badlands. Here's another thought. We still don't know if Noah disobeyed God by allowing woodpeckers onto his ark.

Now that you've received Jesus along with the Holy Spirit through His prayer of salvation, you can look forward, when the time comes, to spending the rest of eternity in Heaven. You will no longer be concerned about winding up in hell. You will never be concerned about demonic activity because you have accepted Jesus. Incidentally, if a person develops a medical condition or another kind of evil situation, he won't ever be able to be helped if he doesn't realize it's from the devil. He won't survive. The Holy Spirit is your comforter because, through Him, you have received His authority, sent by Jesus to be with you. He's here to help you so you can see miracles, signs, and wonders while living and preparing for these remaining days. Jesus is here to reduce and remove any imbalance in you and set you free from all your unnecessary emotional challenges. This includes stuff from the devil such as fear, anxiety, worry, grief, doubt, wounds, hurt, guilt, strife, distress, ego (edging God out), and even depression.

Here's another tough challenge from the devil. When you experience dizziness, lightheadedness, and sometimes crying, you're probably dealing with hyperventilation, which is more common in females. You can reproduce this simply by breathing in and out as deeply as you can for about a minute. You're right, you don't breathe like this, but this is the way you breathe by taking a deep breath every five to seven minutes. This causes respiratory alkalosis from lack of oxygen. Instead of using oxygen, if you were in the emergency room, just touch your index finger on your nose and say, "Stop that in the name of Jesus. Devil, I rebuke you." This is just one way to eliminate this unnecessary emotional activity. Remember, if you sense the devil's presence in what's going on, just say this aloud: "I rebuke you, devil. Come out of me right now in the name of Jesus. I cast you out." ("Rebuke" means "Stop that. That's enough!") Incidentally, anxiety can be reduced or eliminated as follows. Every time you inhale, picture the Holy Spirit coming into you. When you exhale, it's the demonic spirit that's leaving you.

One young man, still in junior high school, came to his father one evening and said, "Dad, I want to grow a beard just like the other kids in school." His father said, "No way." Then the boy told him, "Jesus had a beard." His father replied, "When you can walk on water like Jesus, then you can grow a beard."

### 37. Unity Exists in Your Angels

Did you realize that each of us have been given twenty thousand angels to help us during our lifetime? You need to know that they have been so available that you can use them. How can they help us? Let's take a quick look into that data. God works through angels by directing them to do His bidding. Spiritual reinforcements are always necessary, which is why there is a definite increase in angelic activity. With all the end-time events unfolding, you can sense a spirit of fear. God's angels and the Holy Spirit are on assignment to help us and the church. For example, when you drive your car, they're protecting you. I also pray, "Lord, protect me from the other drivers, and protect the other drivers from me." As you pray and decree, they're making things happen for you.

Angels are working to keep harm from coming to you. Some people see them, sense them, or dream about them. Children often see them. They help you by listening to you while you speak God's word from your mouth. They want to bring God's will for your life into existence. Take advantage of them!

Catch ahold of these:

Angels carry out God's judgment.

Angels serve God.

Angels praise God.

Angels protect God's people.

Angels are messengers.

Angels do not marry.

Angels do not die.

Angels encourage people.

A tired truck driver comes into the restaurant, sits down, looks at the menu, and says to the waitress, "I'll have the liver and onions, and I need a good word from what I've been going through." She writes down the order and proceeds to the kitchen. He says to her, "Wait a minute. what about the good word?" She walks back to him and whispers in his ear, "Don't eat the liver and onions!"

### 38. There Is no Unity in Sin.

The greatest challenge that the sinners fear is how to give up their sins. When I realized that God already loved sinners, I began to work with them and encouraging them that all they had to do was to give up their sins. What they didn't appreciate was that they were already guaranteed success because their authority already existed in them. They possessed the massive and powerful provisions from the mighty name of Jesus Christ that were living in them. This of course included His comforter. the Holy Spirit. Catch the following recommendations for liberty.

The first thing is to get down on your knees before God and confess exactly what these sin things are. Be sure to be brief, but still cover all the facts to eliminate the need for repetition. It's much better to call these truths since facts are contemporary. They can be short-live and unreliable. By speaking the truth, your honesty becomes the precursor to victory, and you will quickly sense that. Leviticus 5:5 explains this., "And it shall be, when he is guilty in any of these matters, that he shall confess that he has sinned in that thing." Psalm 32:5 states, "I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I have not hidden. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord, And You forgave the iniquity of my sin."

One of the God given powers and great forces you have in you is your will. It is believed that even Satan himself and his unholy angels cannot make a person sin when their will has decided not to get involved with sin. The biblical word that explains moving away from sin is called repentance. This means a deliberate change of mind and direction. When you move into a new moral course, away from sin, new neurological synaptic pathways begin to form in your brain. Paul confirms this in Ephesians 4:23, "And be renewed in the spirit of your mind." These are the new patterns of thoughts, feelings, and behaviors which continue to occur with each passing day that is formed in the image of Christ.

When facing those difficult situations when your will power fails, you will require the the love of God. 2 Corinthians 5:14-15 reveals, "The love of Christ is the power that moves us to cease living for ourselves. And to live for Him." This consists of a steady intellectual and emotional inflow of God's love as your source of power over sin. Galatians 5:5-6 states, "For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love" Obviously, love expels sin from the heart.

Paul confirms this. Ephesians 3:11- 12 reveals. "According to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him. You need to receive a steady intellectual and promotional inflow of God's love as your source of power over sin.

There is only one guy standing in line in heaven in front of the large sign that reads "Men Who Don't Listen to their wives."

In the other line is a similar large sign that reads "Men Who Listen to Their Wives," and hundreds of men were standing in that Line to demonstrate that they do listen to their wives. St. Peter walked over to the one guy in the single line and asked, "Who told you to stand here?" He responded, "My wife did."

### 39. Suicide can Only Exist in the Demonic Realm without unity.

This is from The American Foundation for Suicide Prevention. Anyone who has been exposed to a suicide event, especially a family member, will never be able to erase any or all the involved permanent memories. This website

reveals suicide as the tenth leading cause of death in our country. They further claim that 42,773 Americans die annually which means 117 suicides occur each day. It gets worse when the figures reveal that each suicide is associated with twenty-five different attempts. At the root of these multiple causes of suicide is believed to exist a person's inability to handle suffering. This includes physical pain, disability, mental anguish, loneliness, failure, social abuse, etc.

A complete listing of all the apparent causes of suicide are endless. These victims believe they have enough reason to consider that their lives no longer have any value. As a result of their ungodly decision, they all face both physical as well as spiritual suicide.

The only true cause for suicide is actually disclosed in the Scriptures in John 10:10. "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: (Jesus said) I am come that they may have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." Believe it or not, when you don't know Jesus because you're not born again and you haven't received Salvation, the devil takes control and he oversees both your mind and your body.

I passed a guy as I entered the plane going to Las Vegas, sitting in first class. I couldn't help noticing how the gentleman was wearing his wedding ring. I said to him, "Sir, "You have your wedding ring on the wrong finger. He looked up at me and said, "I married the wrong woman." People don't realize what the greatest cause of divorce is marriage.

## 40. Unity for Living in Peace

What we need to do in view of what has been happening, is to start looking for superior ways to live the rest of our days before we head for Heaven. The easiest cause but the most difficult to eliminate is our continuous negative circumstances. We already know that what we say is what we will get. He who guardeth his mouth will save his life, but he who openeth wide his mouth will have destruction. Proverbs 13:3. "He who guards his mouth preserves his life, but he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction."

We already live by too many different mindsets, which reduces the joy we deserve. When we learn to say goodbye to future negative repetitions of the same stuff, our life and being will change to the positive. Nehemiah 8:10 confirms this. "For the joy of the Lord is your strength" To me, joy is not the absence of suffering, but the presence of God. The power of the word is based on God's laws, and since His word is planted in your Spirit, you can look forward to being successful. Living in your Holy Spirit means you are involved in the supernatural realm instead of using your superior intelligence in the wrong realm, the natural one. Your blessing is called a victory.

Keep the right God in your life as you keep in touch with each other. James 4:7. "Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you." When you speak the promises of God three times more than you believe, signs, wonders, and miracles will happen. God gave me the perfect Scripture to handle my worse growing-up emotional challenge because I was Jewish. Exodus 1:12. "But the more they afflicted me, the more I multiplied and grew" When you find God's word through the Scripture, you will overcome your challenges. In Psalm 37:4, you read: "Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart" (Psalm 37:4). The fullness of God occurs when He becomes your requirement and you pray with Him with your whole heart. That's when you get into His presence. Here's further proof. When you want and desire God to the degree that He becomes the major requirement in your life, you will find Him. Here's another confirmation. Psalms 118:130. "The declaration of the word giveth light: and giveth understanding to little ones."

Since God is no respecter of persons, He shows no favoritism. When you become a disciple of Jesus, here's a scriptural gift for you. Romans 10:9–10 "That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation" This is the highest authority that exists. Jesus is still your total answer even if you are still searching for your complete peace. This is vital. You'll never get up on the outside (physically) until you get up on the inside (spiritually), and when you do, you'll promote people to Jesus for Heaven.

My neighbor's mom woke her son up so he could get ready for school. Otherwise, he was going to be late. After several tries, she yelled to him, "John, get up. You don't want to be late for school. You need to get up now!" "But, Mom," he said, "I don't like school."

The teachers don't like me, and if that's not bad enough, the kids don't like me either." His mom responded, "John, you don't have a good-enough excuse not to get up and not go to school. You're the principal, and you don't want to be late."

## 41. Unity Exists with Longevity

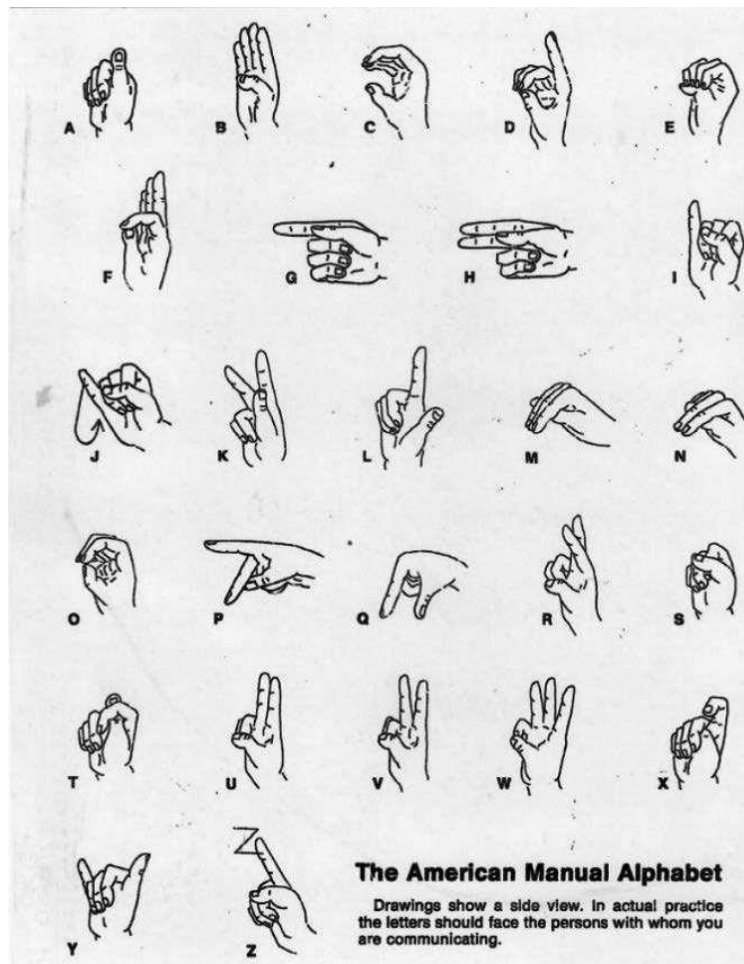
People need to develop the quality in their life of being able to function in a positive mode. Interviews over a twenty-year period confirms this. Positive-thinking individuals live seven and a half years longer on the average than those with negative perceptions of advanced age. This power does involve the subconscious mind. Further, a positive attitude toward aging was correlated with the absence of all forms of degenerative disease. Another symbol you can incorporate into your attitude is PPT, the power of positive thinking. You need to realize you have the both the knowledge and the ability to create changes in your life expectancy. That means you must lean toward a successful and longer life by being outgoing, charismatic, and focused on a fruitful lifestyle. Catch this difficult to believe testimony of a patient dying from cancer. His doctor friend told a new drug was about to be tested for this devastating condition. Without any trials, his doctor couldn't expose his close friend to any risks. However, he begged his doctor to become involved. His doctor figured he had nothing to lose and everything to gain to save his friends life except for the obvious legal dangers. His doctor "gave in" and he received the medication trial even though the drug was untested. Ten days later, the patient walked out of the hospital cancer free. This, unfortunately, is a true story. Several months later, the patient investigated the response to this drug through his doctor. It failed and consequently it was never put on the market. When the patient learned the results, he died two days later. If he had only ignored the unnecessary follow-up, he would still be alive today. Positive affirmations are so real. When you are confronted with a generation curse for a sickness or disease from a family member, simple "rebuke it" and Jesus will make it disappear. From now on, avoid viewing aging from a negative point of view. By the way, Dr. Alexis Carrel, a Nobel Prize winner, has proven that individual cells kept in the proper environment can become immortal. You can develop the healthful countenance of an independent centenarian. Just reset your mental goals to live longer. The oldest confirmed human being lived to be 163 years. His Indonesian ID card claimed the date of his birth was December 31, 1870. The secret for maintaining this, of course, is to place Jesus Christ of Nazareth in charge. Isaiah 40:3. "But those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint"

The lost Amelia Earhart sent a message back in which she had written, "Stop trying to find me and find my luggage instead." I never understood why people would want to purchase Amelia Earhart luggage. This is an oxymoron of sorts (e.g., a depressed comedian). ### American Sign Language

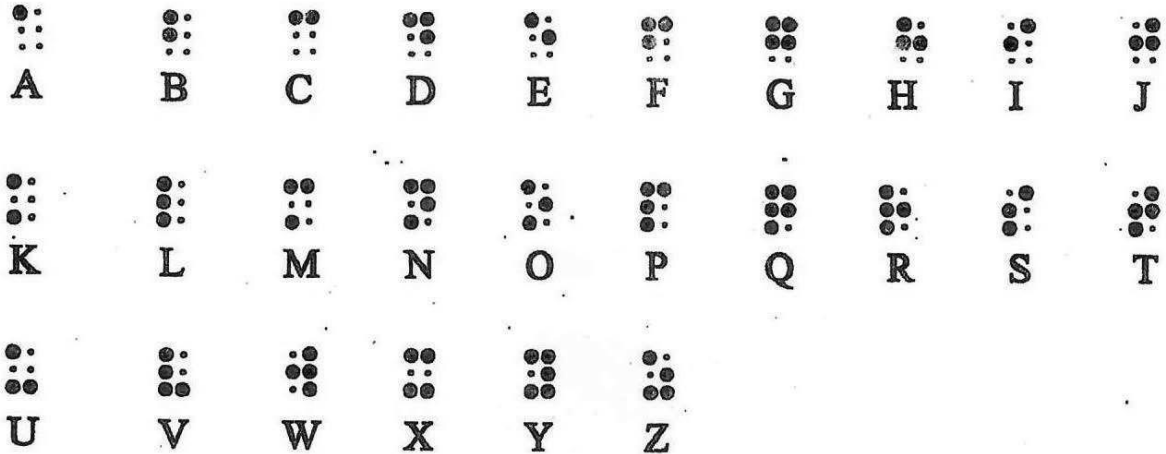

There are multiple uses for Braille, and becoming an instructor is an awesome blessing for the impaired. A person who reads Braille can work independently throughout their community, and these believers are showing up everywhere. Of course, a miracle healing will completely resolve the situation.

- 3) Pray in tongues. Ask the Lord for wisdom utilizing the idea, the concepts, and the resources He is bringing. James 1:5. "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him"
- 4) Use your faith. Romans 4:17. "God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did"
- 5) Give unto the Lord for this is about administering the gift. He loves our cheerful giving, so He provides more so we can bless more people. 2 Corinthians 9 also includes the cheerful giver.

Take these in steps and put them into practice. See the camels loaded down with God's provision and favor for yourself. Get your heart prepared for what God is beginning to do both in and through you as we usher in the soon return of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
